Third Lord's Day of Epiphany

Jesus gave us wine to drink in this Holy Communion because He drank the cup of God's wrath in order to give us the cup of the kingdom. This wine, the cup of the New Covenant, says that we have peace with God and that we share in Jesus' victory over sin, death, and the Devil. Wine says that the King has come and that we are citizens of His heavenly kingdom. And this feast is only a foretaste, a down-payment, on the feast of all feasts—the Marriage Supper of the Lamb. The King has come, and He will come again.

If you've been baptized into Christ and are seeking to live faithfully and obediently for Him, you are invited to partake of this feast that our gracious God has provided for us. These are the gifts of God for the people of God.
