

Eucharistic Homily

Palm Sunday

April 5, 2020

This Holy Communion is an invitation to follow Jesus to glory by walking on the way of the cross. In this Eucharistic meal, Jesus gives us His body that was broken and His blood that was poured out for us on the cross. Through this feast the Holy Spirit imparts to us the blessings that Jesus secured for us through His sacrificial death on the cross. This holy food is a promise of the future glory and resurrection life that awaits us.

But we do not receive these blessings so that we can hoard them for ourselves. Jesus gives us His body and blood in order to form us into His body so that we can live together in a way that reflects His selfless love. This is how Jesus draws all men to Himself and the blessings of this Table flow out to the nations.
