In Colossians 2, Paul warns the believers not to be led astray by counterfeit, worldly “wisdom” because all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge are hidden in Christ Jesus. There are all sorts of philosophies and false religions and self-help techniques that promise a good life apart from Christ, but they can't deliver what they promise. Abundant life and blessing are only found in Jesus. Only the death and resurrection of Jesus are sufficient to provide freedom from sin and death.

Here at this Table, we are instructed in the deep wisdom of God made manifest to us in Christ. He is our life. His word is the only path to life and blessing. We who share in His death by crucifying our flesh will also share in His resurrection glory at the Last Day.

If you've been baptized into Christ and are seeking to live faithfully and obediently for Him, you are invited to partake of this feast that our gracious God has provided for us. These are the gifts of God for the people of God.
